

VCA RULES FOR STAYING IN HOTEL

THERE WILL BE SOMEONE FROM THE VCA CHECKING THE MOTELS/HOTELS AND THE RV AREA AT UNSCHEDULED TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AND EVENINGS. PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT BEING CONSCIENTIOUS DOG OWNERS WILL BE GIVEN A WARNING. THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IF THERE IS A SECOND INFRACTION.

- 1) Dogs may **not** be left unattended loose in the rooms. They **MUST** be crated.
- 2) Dog owners will clean up after their dogs.
- 3) Dog owner's sheets/blankets must be used to cover the hotel beds if the dogs are allowed on them.
- 4) Plastic will be given to you at check-in to put under your crates in the room. This must be used.
- 5) Dogs must not be allowed to pee in the rooms, nor lift its leg on shrubbery, landscaping, pillars, etc., surrounding the motels and show site.
- 6) Do not allow your dogs to bark or whine excessively. If you cannot leave your dogs without them barking, etc., dogs need to be put in your car (weather permitting) and car should be parked away from the buildings. Dogs should be brought with you to the show site even if they are not participating in the show that day.
- 7) Hotel staff must be allowed in the room once per day to clean the rooms.
- 8) Hotel towels should NOT be used for dog related uses, nor should dogs be bathed in the motel room.

I/we agree to the above rules and will abide by them. I/we further agree that the motel can give room access to the VCA 2019 Event Chair, the VCA 2019 Compliance Director or their designee at any reasonable time without notice, for the duration of the room rental.
