Taliesin East – Frank Lloyd Wright’s Country Home – 5607 County Hwy C, Spring Green, WI - A beautiful home in a beautiful country setting.

Circus World Museum – 550 Water Street, Baraboo, WI (near Wisconsin Dells) – Home of the circus train and circus memorabilia

National Railroad Museum – 2285 South Broadway, Green Bay – Railroad artifacts & memorabilia along with 20 steam and diesel engines, plus items of rolling stock.
