



This unique showcase is designed to spotlight the dogs that have achieved the pinnacle of success in our breed. Open only to AKC Show Champions that also hold either a Field Championship, Amateur Field Championship, Master Hunter title or NAVHDA Utility Prize I title, this prestigious competition highlights the importance of form to function in a breed where this remains a priority.



ALL STAR REVIEW RULES

Format: A panel of three knowledgeable Vizsla fanciers will judge the All Star Review. The identities of the judges will be kept secret until the night of the event. The dogs will be judged using the breed standard.

There will be no division into classes by sex or title. Two winners will emerge from the ranks of the breed's most accomplished dogs. The Best in Review and Best Veteran in Review results will be announced at the conclusion of the All Star Review showcase.

PLEASE NOTE: The purpose of the All Star Review is to showcase the quality and accomplishments of Vizslas and their owners. Your hard work, dedication, commitment of time and resources are being honored and recognized by your peers. In order to do so, we ask that each exhibitor be owner-handled. PROFESSIONAL HANDLERS (INCLUDING PRO FIELD HANDLERS/TRAINERS) MAY HANDLE ONLY DOGS THAT THEY OWN OR CO-OWN. A professional handler/trainer is defined as anyone who accepts compensation for handling a dog in the show ring or field.

Entry Requirements: AKC Champion dogs/bitches that also hold a Field Championship, Amateur Field Championship, Master Hunter title or NAVHDA Utility Prize I title on or before the close of entries. The completion dates of BOTH titles must be entered on the entry form. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete.

Previous winners may enter the Best In Review Exhibitor Class. This very special class recognizes past winners of this prestigious event. Participants will be showcased in the catalog, presented an All Star engraved ribbon, presented in the ring, but will not be eligible for the Adele Neupert Memorial Trophy.

Entrants also have the option to reserve a catalog at a discounted price of \$5.

Prizes: Each participating dog will receive a rosette engraved with his or her name. The Best In Review and Best Veteran In Review will receive a special trophy. A plaque will be added to the Adele Neupert Memorial Trophy to honor the winner of Best In Review. This is not a traveling trophy.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$50 for the All Star Review and \$25 for the Best In Review class made payable to "All Star Review". This fee includes entry into the All Star Review, a 2-page catalog advertisement, which includes a half-page picture and biography plus a 3-generation pedigree, a special engraved rosette with the dog's name, event and year.

The biography, photo, pedigree and fee must be received by Diane Fazio by the closing date of April 6, 2022. (Info on bio page.) Please sign the signature waiver for all overnight-mailed entries. All Star entry fee do NOT go to the show superintendent.
